I understand that the Sautee Nacoochee Art Festival accepts only art pieces that I have made as an original creation. No manufactured or imported goods are allowed. Show officials have the right to remove any disallowed items or violations. I agree to have my display space set up by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, February 16 and staffed the entire weekend of the Festival. **Displays may not be dismantled until 4:00 p.m. on Sunday.** I hereby waive any claim to action for any damages, including but not limited to those based on negligence against the Sautee Nacoochee Community Association, Inc., the Sautee Nacoochee Center, or the Sautee Nacoochee Art Festival Committee arising from injury to my person or damage or loss of my artwork. This is a rain or shine Art Festival and no rain dates or refunds are planned in the event the Art Festival must be cancelled. If for any reason I am unable to attend the Festival, as a courtesy to my fellow artists and the committee, I will notify the Festival immediately by telephone. Should an emergency arise during the Festival and it is necessary for me to leave, I will notify a Festival official before I dismantle my display. I will be totally responsible for collecting appropriate State sales tax.

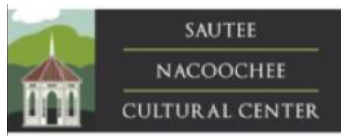

Artist Application:

The Sautee Nacoochee Center is proud to host its ninth annual Sautee Nacoochee Art Festival on our historic campus! Located in the beautiful mountains of Northeast Georgia, Sautee Nacoochee has for several years been acclaimed as one of the “Best Small Arts Towns in America”.

The Sautee Nacoochee Center campus has a 1927 restored brick schoolhouse containing two art galleries, a history museum and a 98-seat theatre. Also on campus are the Folk Pottery Museum of Northeast Georgia, an African-American Heritage Site, a blacksmith shed and a historical gymnasium where a variety of activities and performances take place.

The Sautee Nacoochee Art Festival will feature many artists who will exhibit and sell their original works of art in a variety of mediums. No kits, molded items, commercially formed items (including commercially printed matter) antiques, plants, or imports will be allowed. Items cannot include commercial designs. Any artist whose work is found to be unoriginal or inconsistent with the work submitted for consideration will be asked to leave the Art Festival.

The 2024 Sautee Nacoochee Art Festival again this year will be in partnership with the area’s WinterFest Arts Tour event. This includes SNCA, Helen Arts & Heritage Center’s Winter Arts Festival, Unicoi’s Annual Fireside Arts and Crafts Show & Hardman Farm.

Festival Features:

- 26* exhibit spaces, measuring 10’x10’, all located in our historic gymnasium and community hall. First come, first served!
 - Overnight security will be provided.
 - Your name and contact information in the Festival program.
 - Multimedia advertising and marketing.
 - Free parking for visitors. No admission charge.
- *We will increase spaces if Covid guidelines allow us to do so.*

Exhibit Space Specifications:

Each exhibit space measures 10’x10’ and will be located as indicated above. Display equipment and all materials must be limited to and kept within the assigned space. Be prepared for rain or shine weather although this is an indoor event. Absolutely NO smoking is permitted at the Festival. Pets must be leashed at all times.

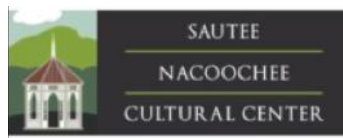
